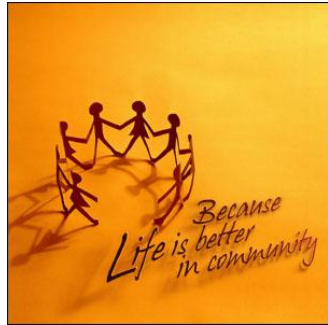

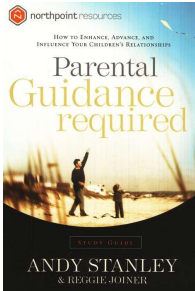

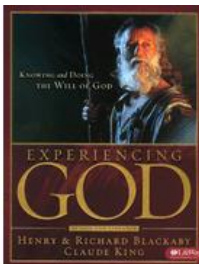

Experiencing God

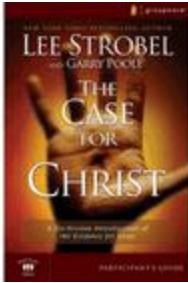

The Case for Christ

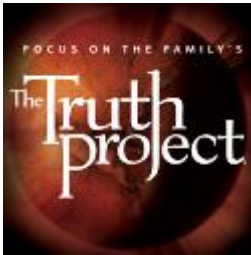

The Truth Project

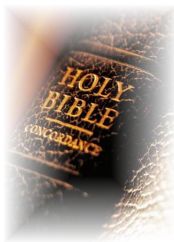

The Gospel of John

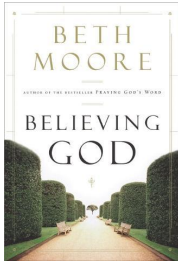
John's Gospel is one of the easiest and most practical books in all of the Bible. In this Study you will come to know Christ in a personal and loving way.

Believing God

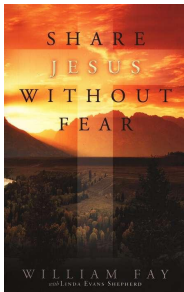

Frequently Asked Questions

- **Will childcare be available?**

Though every group will determine their own childcare needs, there will be childcare and classes for children on Saturdays at 5:30 p.m., on Sundays at 9:00 a.m., and on Wednesdays at 7:00 p.m.

- **Is it okay to miss a few weeks if I go on vacation?**

Absolutely, we want families to take time together, and we don't want this to keep anyone from signing up to be a part of a small group.

- **What if I don't know that much about the Bible?**

Though the Foundations classes are designed for beginners, all of our groups are led by people who will make learning the Bible easy no matter what your experience may be.

- **What if I don't know anybody in the group?**

The nature of these groups means that everyone begins together. Special care will be taken to help participants get to know and build lasting friendships.

- **What are the beginning and ending dates?**

The small groups will begin the week June 6th and run through August 27th.

- **How big are the groups**

Group size will be no less than 8 people and no more than 20.

- **Can I switch groups if I get in and it is not what I expected?**

Groups will remain open for 3 weeks after beginning. As long as there is room in the other group, you are free to move. After that point, groups will close so that focus is not lost.

- **How do I sign up?**

You can sign up every Sunday by filling out your connection card and marking which small group you would like to join. You can also sign up over the phone by calling the church office or online at www.cbclife.net.

On May 31 there will be a small groups information table available for you to talk to someone concerning the groups.

- **How do I get the materials?**

If your particular study has a booklet or study guide associated with it, one will be ordered for you and be available for pick up on the first day of the small group. If a workbook is not specified, we suggest you bring your Bible, a notebook and pen so that you can get the most out of every study.
